We already have two coaches for the men team, but are looking for a more experienced coach and want to offer this opportunity to come live in Germany. Because of that, you would have the flexibility to not be at every single practice, if you have to study/work or just want to explore Germany and Europe on a trip. Of course we would help you with your transition to Germany and everything connected to it like authorities and moving. Expect a welcoming culture and friends over here.

ABOUT THE CLUB

We have 60 members and we target a growth to 80 at the end of the year 2020. We have a men, a women team and a youth program for boys. Around half of the members belong to the men team, where we have a variety of levels from rookie to Division I players. Our practice is always in English and our team very international with some very experienced American players from four different US Army bases around Nuremberg.

STUDYING
